If you would like to pick up your child's homework you may leave that information on the answering machine. This request has to be made by 10:00 am in order for the teacher to have time to prepare the assignments. Homework can be picked up in the school office at the regular dismissal time.

If your child has a fever (100 degrees or higher), please keep them at home. No one should return to school until they have had no fever for 24 hours without the use of a fever-reducing medicine, even if they feel better. Thank you.
