Will function like a Ring camera/video to chat with Main Office. -CAASSP scores- ELA school wide is 80%, Math is 76% -Scores are a true accomplishment for our school. Esp taking in distance learning and math building -3 areas looking at – ELD students, free and reduced lunch District common assessments 2-6 th grades. Rigor is high. Interim assessments. Align to CAASP and Common Core Standards. 6 th grade last week had Academic Conference Release Day. Used a matrix for each question and each child to explore data for standards and questions covered in these assessments. Used data to create SMART goals for instruction. 6 th Grade created a goal -10,000\$ Grant from last year to work on writing programs for all grade levels (Not every school is doing these writing programs- only school that is aligned with 3 three programs. Teachers aligned themselves and pulled in these 3 writing programs – K using Writing Units of Study, 1-3 Write Tools, 4-6 Being a Writer- Collaborative Classroom publisher) Teachers looking at each test question and each standard K/1 did more baseline assessment on Phonics and baseline knowledge. -Working on push in model for RSP teacher with a specific target group in classes. Also using Instructional Aide. Allows all students to have grade level curriculum and instruction. -Hired part time Special Ed teacher – retired teacher that will also do Push in “Inclusive model” instruction Will continue to do in 2 nd and 3 rd trimesters to reassess and relook at data -5 th Grade will do Academic Conference Release Day next week -This is Data Driven Instruction Model- CR is very lucky to have teachers do | Mr. Zarate |
